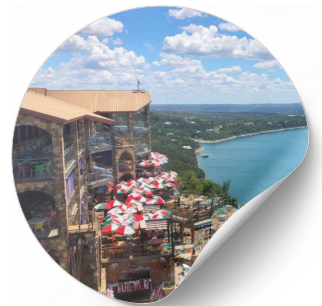
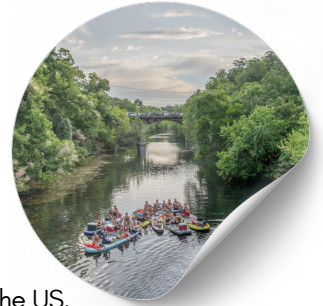

Places to Visit & Things to Do

1. **Austin Nature and Science Center** - Ecological refuge that lets kids explore, discover and learn about geology, animals, paleontology, astronomy, and more.
2. **Austin Helicopter Tour** - Take in some spectacular aerial views of the city.
3. **ATX Sculpture at Whole Foods** - Take a selfie with the beloved and iconic sign.
4. **Austin Aquarium** - See marine animals, reptiles, and exotic birds.
5. **Austin Brewery Tour** - Take advantage of all-inclusive tours.
6. **Austin Zoo** - Every visit promises a one-of-a-kind experience immersed in joy.
7. **Cathedral of Junk** - A unique and eclectic art structure.
8. **Circuit of the Americas** - Premier destination for world-class motorsports and entertainment in the US.
9. **Hope Outdoor Gallery** - Developed to provide muralists, street artists, arts education classes and community groups the opportunity to display outdoor art.
10. **Horseback Riding** - Lots of local ranches and riding trails around the Austin area.
11. **Lake Travis Zip-Lining** - The Austin area has the longest zip-lines in Texas.
12. **Lone Star Riverboat Cruises** - Take a sunset tour on the Colorado River.
13. **Local Murals** - Take a drive around Austin to see a mix of eclectic and colorful murals.
14. **George Washington Carver Museum, Cultural & Genealogy Center** - Museum that pays homage to Austin's African-American heritage.
15. **The Oasis** - Largest outdoor restaurant in the country with Sunset dining over Lake Travis.
16. **Pennybacker Bridge** - See brag-worthy views of West Austin and the scenic Hill Country.
17. **Pinballz Arcade** - Classic arcade games and modern thrills.
18. **Stevie Ray Vaughan Statue** - Popular tourist attraction in Auditorium Shores.
19. **Texas State Capitol Building and Visitor Center** - The three-story castle-like structure is the oldest state office building in Texas.
20. **University of Texas** - Check out the Littlefield Fountain, UT Tower or see a UT home football game.
21. **Blanton Museum of Art** - Amazing collection of art and sculptures.
22. **Bullock Texas State History Museum** - Great place to learn about the history of Texas.
23. **Umlauf Sculpture Garden & Museum** - Over 50 sculptures in a peaceful 6-acre garden near Barton Springs.
24. **LBJ Presidential Library** - One of fourteen presidential libraries administered by the National Archives and Records Administration.
25. **Mexic-arte Museum** - A collection of art and free standing sculptures by Mexican and Mexican-American artists.
26. **Museum of the Weird** - Shrunken heads, weird animals, unique bugs, and more.
27. **Magic's Theater** - Intimate magic show with close-up tricks and stage illusions, paired with a private collection of Hollywood memorabilia for a captivating experience.
28. **SXSW** - South by Southwest (SXSW) is an annual conglomeration of parallel film, interactive media, and music festivals and conferences organized jointly that take place in mid-March.
29. **Lake Travis** - Lake Travis is a favorite spot for water activities and scenic views.
30. **ACL Festival** - Annual music festival that takes place in Zilker Park on two consecutive three-day weekends and is inspired by the KLRU/PBS music series Austin City Limits.
31. **Sparky Park** - Electrical sub station turned into eccentric art.
32. **Texas State Cemetery** - A beautiful cemetery for notable Texas icons.
33. **The Contemporary Austin at Laguna Gloria** - Venture through the grounds to discover art by contemporary artists from around the world.
34. **Museum of Ice Cream** - Interactive museum in Soho with colorful exhibits and unlimited ice cream, featuring a sprinkle pit and a NY subway-inspired environment.



35. **Xiang Yun Temple** - Bodhisattva monastery of Humanistic Buddhism.
36. **Zilker Botanical Garden** - Often called "the jewel in the heart of Austin". Theme gardens are interconnected with streams, waterfalls and Koi-filled ponds.
37. **Ann and Roy Butler Hike & Bike Trail** - Trails run along the lake and take you through Zilker Park, Butler Park, Auditorium Shores, and the Long Center for the Performing Arts.
38. **Austin Bouldering Project** - Great climbing routes for climbers of all ages.
39. **Barton Creek Greenbelt** - Great for hiking, bouldering, and climbing.
40. **The Driskill** - Historic hotel featuring western decor, live music in the bar and a charming cafe'.
41. **Kalahari** - Voted #1 Best Indoor Water Park with 350,000 square feet of waterpark fun.
42. **Deep Eddy Pool** - Oldest spring-fed swimming pool in TX.
43. **Barton Springs Pool** - Fed by four bubbling springs, this natural wonder maintains a brisk 68-70° year 'round.
44. **Bob Wentz Park** - A popular spot for scuba diving, windsurfing, sailing, and swimming. make learning fun!
45. **Bull Creek Greenbelt** - There are lots of great secluded swimming holes, hiking trails, and a short, wide waterfall.
46. **Emma Long Metropolitan Park** - Swimming hole with a true beach off Lake Austin.
47. **Hippie Hollow Park** - Great swimming and the only legally recognized clothing optional public park in Texas.
48. **Mount Bonnell** - Nice hike and great view of the city.
49. **Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Center** - Explore wildflowers and native plants of Texas in beautiful gardens.
50. **Lady Bird Lake** - Go on a cruise, kayak, or SUP.
51. **Longhorn Cavern State Park** - Exciting cavern tours.
52. **Mansfield Dam Park on Lake Travis** - Popular boating and swimming spot.
53. **Mayfield Park and Nature Preserve** - Lush gardens and brilliant peacocks surround lily and koi fish filled ponds.
54. **McKinney Falls State Park** - Beautiful waterfall, 700 acres of hiking trails, and camping.
55. **WonderSpaces** - Interactive art space with engaging exhibits, including VR and light installations.
56. **Westcave Outdoor Discovery Center** - Check out the very popular natural grotto and the stunning 40 ft. waterfall.
57. **Allens Boots** - Has more than 4,000 boots on display plus cowboy hats and clothing.
58. **Antonelli's Cheese Shop** - Over 100 different types of cheese and fun tasting opportunities.
59. **Big Top Candy Shop** - Circus style sweets, old-school confections, and a classic soda fountain.
60. **Bookpeople** - Huge selection of books of every genre.
61. **City Wide Garage Sale** - Austin's famous vintage market.
62. **East Austin Succulents** - Cacti and succulent nursery.
63. **Feather's Boutique Vintage** - Women's vintage items, from various clothing to jewelry and shoes.
64. **Kick Pleat** - Women's boutique in a little house.
65. **Stag Provisions for Men** - Named a "Top 10 Men's Store In America" by GQ & Esquire Magazines.
66. **Tesoros Trading Company** - Folk arts and crafts.
67. **TX Custom Boots** - Design your very own cowboy boots.
68. **Toms Austin & Cafe** - Large shoe collection as well as a small cafe with coffee and pastry.
69. **Uncommon Objects** - Eclectic items curated by over 20 antique sellers.
70. **Waterloo Records** - For decades, Waterloo Records & Video has been a cornerstone of Austin's music scene.
71. **Antone's Nightclub** - A must stop for blues enthusiasts!
72. **Austin City Limits or ACL Live at the Moody Theater** - Great acoustics in a small, intimate venue.
73. **Blue Starlite Mini Urban Drive-In** - Old-time drive-in.
74. **Broken Spoke** - Last of the true Texas Dance-halls.
75. **Carousel Lounge** - Circus-themed lounge.
76. **The Continental Club** - Legendary South Congress club with local rock, country, jazz, and blues acts.
77. **Donn's Depot** - Piano Bar with live music.
78. **Ego's** - Relaxed drinking and high-energy karaoke.
79. **The Elephant Room** - Underground Jazz bar.
80. **Esther's Follies** - Magic, juggling, singing, dancing, and sketches. Most of the acts incorporate a comedic theme.
81. **Historic Scoot Inn** - Live music usually eclectic indie bands.
82. **Little Longhorn Saloon** - Play Chicken Shit Bingo.
83. **Mohawk Austin** - Multilevel bar with rooftop area and indoor/outdoor stages for live performances.
84. **The Long Center** - Home to the Austin Symphony. Orchestra, Austin Lyric Opera and Ballet Austin.
85. **One World Theater** - Music and live theater.
86. **Paramount Theater** - Live theatre venue & movie theatre.
87. **White Horse** - Catch live bluegrass, country-western and Americana bands seven nights a week.
88. **Reimers Ranch Park** - A nice beach area to swim and sunbathe plus good limestone sport-climbing.
89. **Hamilton Pool Reserve** - A natural grotto and swimming hole with a waterfall.
90. **Pace Bend Park** - Lake recreation, cliff trails, camping, mountain biking, climbing, sports fields and courts.
91. **Jacob's Well Natural Area** - Popular swimming hole with the biggest underwater cave system.
92. **Blue Hole Park** - A scenic lagoon bordered by limestone bluffs along the South Fork of the San Gabriel River.
93. **Blue Hole Regional Park** - Scenic swimming hole with green foliage, clear water, and grassy areas for picnics.
94. **Devil's Watering Hole at Inks Lake State Park** - Known for its cliff jumping and swimming.
95. **Guadalupe River State Park** - Great tubing, swimming and canoeing.
96. **The Thinkery** - Offers 40,000 sq. ft. of learning space with interactive exhibits and hands-on activations designed to spark children's curiosity and most importantly make learning fun!
97. **Dell Diamond** - Home stadium of the Round Rock Express, the Triple-A Minor League Baseball affiliate of the TX Rangers.
98. **Watching Bats** - North America's largest urban bat population viewed under the Congress Bridge.
99. **South Congress Avenue (SoCo)** - This vibrant neighborhood south of Lady Bird Lake is a must-stroll.
100. **Austin FC** - Austin FC is the home team for MLS.
101. **The Domain** - Outdoor mall featuring designer stores, diverse dining and unique shops.
