



What's the Difference Between An Access Easement and a Right of Way Easement?

An access easement grants to a third party the right to pass on, over or under a certain tract of land.

A right of way easement grants the right to enter onto, over or under a property for a specific purpose, such as installing and maintaining utilities. The right of way also grants access over a portion of the property to exercise those rights.

What are the Two Types of Road Maintenance Agreements?

Generally, there are two types of road maintenance agreements.

1) A platted PUD subdivision contains private streets, and the road maintenance provisions are almost always found printed on the plat, NOT in the restrictions.
