EDUCATION

Our families living in Santa Rita Ranch North will be zoned to schools in Georgetown ISD. GISD schools offer diverse educational experiences and extensive community partnerships to create first-class students—and with their extraordinary 14:1 student to teacher ratio, 97% pass rate of the STAAR test, and score of 21:7 on the college readiness index, it's working. Pickett Elementary

Residents who live in Tierra Rosa are zoned to attend Pickett Elementary school for grades Kindergarten-5. Pickett Elementary currently holds around 350 students and 70 staff members in the Georgetown ISD. Students who attend Pickett Elementary School have several extracurricular activities to choose from including competing in academic UIL competitions, Honor Choir, Seaperch underwater robotics, Art, and so much more.

Tippit Middle School

Tippit Middle School is a public middle school for grades 6-8, currently hosting over 790 students in the Georgetown ISD. From the \$160 million that was issued in the 2015 Georgetown ISD bond, Tippit Middle School will see the most growth and improvements with \$26 million dollars reserved for this campus. Plans are in place for new infrastructure, technology upgrades, classroom improvements with a focus on transformational learning, and so much more.

EAST VIEW HIGH SCHOOL

Eastview High School is a public high school hosting nearly 1,500 students in grades 9-12 and is classified as a UIL 4A campus in the Georgetown ISD. This high school has many awards and accolades under their belt, including the 9th best high school in the greater Austin area by High School Sound Off, recognized as one of the best public high schools in the nation by Niche K-12, and one of "America's Best High Schools" by US News and World Report.
