

WESTLAKE Texas

Just six miles from downtown, West Lake Hills is one of the most exclusive areas in all of Austin, Texas. Incorporated as a village in 1953, homes there are now prized as much for their location along winding, hilly roads as for their proximity to both downtown and Lake Austin.

West Lake Hills is unique in many ways. The citizens, along with their elected and appointed officials, are dedicated to preserving the rural environment and maintaining the natural beauty of the area.

Westlake consistently receives recognition at all levels, including its rank among the 100 best high schools in the country by Newsweek and US News magazines. The school consistently exceeds both regional and state standardized test score averages in all categories.

Westlake students excel academically, as well as in music, arts and athletics. WHS consistently boasts impressive numbers in the National Merit competition and Presidential Scholars program. Traditionally, about 99 percent of students are accepted directly to college. On average, more than \$20 million in scholarships is offered to WHS grads annually.

Westlake High School offers a full slate of Advanced Placement courses, a Career and Technical Education program, an acclaimed Performing Arts department, as well as special support programs such as the TLC (The Learning Center) and Adult Transition Services (formerly 19+ program).

Westlake is a sprawling campus that includes a dedicated Ninth Grade Center. In 2008-09, a choir room was added, and the Research Center and Performing Arts Center were renovated. The 2011 bond program provided safety updates in the stadium, roofing, flooring, PAC equipment upgrades, as well as major updates to the Family Consumer Science classrooms, TLC and Alternative Education Program. The 2015 bond program included the construction of a new Robotics facility and upgrades to the Chaparral Stadium sound system.





Many families, and professionals of all types, are attracted to West Lake Hills because of the aforementioned school district and the close proximity to downtown Austin. Westlake is the only suburb of Austin located entirely within the coveted Eanes Independent School District

The Austin Country Club, located in the Westlake neighborhood of Davenport Ranch, offers a 180-acre, 18-hole golf course designed by renowned architect Pete Dye, 10 lighted tennis courts (of which two are clay), a heated, 50-meter pool, a 57-slip marina and boat club, and a clubhouse with dining and meeting rooms and a large ballroom.
